For I do not want you to be unaware, brethren, that **ALL** **OUR FATHERS**

- 1) were **all** under the cloud, and
- 2) **all** passed through the sea; and
- 3) **all** were baptized into Moses in the cloud and in the sea; and
- 4) **all** ate the same spiritual food; and
- 5) **all** drank the same spiritual drink, (for they were drinking from a spiritual rock which followed them; and the rock was Christ.)

Nevertheless, **with most of them God was not well-pleased;** for they were laid low in the wilderness.

Now **these things** happened as examples for us, that **EXAMPLES**

- 1) *WE SHOULD NOT CRAVE EVIL THINGS*, as they also craved. And Ex. 16:3
- 2) *DO NOT BE IDOLATERS*, as some of them were; as it is written, Exodus 32 "The people sat down to eat and drink, and stood up to play."
- 3) *NOR LET US ACT IMMORALLY*, as some of them did, and Num.25 twenty-three thousand fell in one day. Sickness
- 4) *NOR LET US TRY THE LORD*, as some of them did, and Num.21 were destroyed by the serpents. Serpents
- 5) *NOR GRUMBLE*, as some of them did, and Num.16 were destroyed by the destroyer. Satan




Our object lessons in the Present

Now **these things** happened to them as an example, and they were written for our instruction, upon whom the ends of the ages have come. **ESCAPE**

Therefore let him who thinks he stands take heed lest he fall.

- a) No temptation has overtaken you but such as is common to man;
- b) and God is faithful, who
 - (1) will not allow you to be tempted beyond what you are able,
 - (2) but (with the temptation) will provide **the way of escape** also, that you may be able to endure it.
