


Introduction:

IV. What do I need to do to bear fruit?
1. Completely reject God created you to bear much fruit. Rachel (Genesis 30:1) Give me children, or I die. Hanna (I Samuel 1:10-11) Let it bother you. Sterility is a curse.
2 It is the Spirit who prepares you to give birth to spiritual fruit. Luke 1:35 Acts 1:8 power to bear fruit Not Ishmael, from fleshly effort, but Isaac, by God's grace
